Gentle Reminder on Dress Code

There are two codes of dress, known as "Mid Grey not Pale Grey" or "Whites".

"Greys" :- Mid Grey not Pale Grey trousers/skirts and white above the waist.

"Whites" :- White trousers/skirts and white above the waist.

Club Polo shirts may be worn with "Mid Grey not Pale Grey" or "Whites".

"Greys" are worn for Dave Condon Triples, Club Roll Ups, Mens' S&D League and Mixed S&D League (with club shirt),

Mens' S&D County competitions, Club Internal competitions.

"Whites" are worn for Ladies S&D League (with club shirt) , Ladies S&D County competitions, Friendly Matches (with club shirt).

Men may wear shirts, long or short sleeved or polo shirts with long or short sleeves. Grey shorts may be worn providing they are tailored as per bowls regulation shorts.

Ladies may wear blouses with collars, long or short sleeved, (not sleeveless) or polo shirts with long or short sleeves.

Trousers, cropped trousers or shorts may be worn providing they are tailored as per bowls regulation items.

Shorts can be worn for Dave Condon Triples, Internal competitions and Roll Ups.

Club polo shirts are worn for all club representative matches with "Greys" or "Whites" depending on the fixture.

The dress code for matches is indicated on the fixture card/match sheet.

Regulation brown, grey or white bowling shoes must be worn at all times.

Sun hats/caps may be worn but must be plain white only. (no colours or mottos).

Cold /wet weather wear consists of white fleeces, jumpers, cardigans or official bowls wet weather wear. There are club jackets.
